Where will the money come from?


You could get a gift of money from family for your birthday or even Christmas. You could also ask your parents/guardian if there are regular chores you could do for an allowance or pocket money.


Investigate

Origami Instructions






² Fold up all four corners so that the points meet in the middle.




5 It should now look like this. Flip it over.

Origami Game


Carefully cut along the dotted line to start playing!
