

Notification to Bank of Ireland Customers

Using Bank of Ireland ATM only cards in AIB ATMs

Do you have a Bank of Ireland ATM only card?

By ATM only card, we mean a card you can only use at ATMs - not a Visa Debit card which can be used at ATMs and Point of Sale.

No more cash withdrawals at AIB ATMs

From 3 April 2014, AIB will no longer accept Bank of Ireland ATM only cards for cash withdrawals from AIB ATMs. This will apply to personal and business customers.

Which ATM cards will be affected?

The following ATM cards will be affected by this AIB change:

- All personal and business current account ATM only cards
- Personal and business demand deposit ATM only cards

Visa debit cards will not be affected

Bank of Ireland customers with Visa Debit cards can continue to use their card to withdraw cash at ATMs in Ireland and worldwide, wherever you see the Visa symbol.

We would like to remind customers that, where we notify you of any changes to the terms and conditions of your Account that you do not wish to accept, you may end your contract with us. However, before you can do this you must first pay us any money, interest, fees, charges or Government Duty that you owe in connection with your Account. If you do not ask us to end your contract, you are deemed to have accepted the changes on their effective date. In this instance the effective date of the changes is 3 April 2014.
