

Notification to Bank of Ireland Customers

We would like to advise Personal Current Account customers (Personal ATM/ Debit Cards) of a change to the Terms and Conditions. This change will come into effect on the 1st September 2014.

Existing Version – Clause 2.6

“When you receive your Visa Debit Card, you must activate it at one of our ATMs. The activation of your card is acceptance of these Card terms and conditions.”

New Version - Clause 2.6

“When you receive your Visa Debit Card, you must activate it at one of our ATMs. If activation does not take place within 60 days of the issue of the Card, in the interest of card security, the card will be cancelled and a new card will have to be applied for. The activation of your card is acceptance of these Card terms and conditions.”

If you do not accept the above change to the Terms and Conditions of your Card, you may end your Card contract with us. To do this you must first pay us Government Duty (if any) that you owe concerning your Card. If you do not ask us to end your Card contract, you will be deemed to have accepted the change on this effective date: 1st Sept 2014.
